

Nomadland is a mediational film that follows a woman in her sixties who, after losing her job and everything that might keep her in one place, moves into a van as she journeys through the American West. Nomadland won Best Picture, Best Actress, and Best Director at the 2021 Academy Awards — making director Chloe Zhao the second of only three women to earn the award and the first woman of colour.



Dark Girls is a documentary about the deep-rooted colourism in the Black community — as well as outside it — that surrounds lighter skin versus darker skin.



Kena and Ziki both dream of a life beyond the stifling confines of their conservative Nairobi neighbourhood. From the moment the two young women meet, the connection is clear. Torn between the romantic desire to follow their hearts and the pragmatic need to follow their heads, the star-crossed lovers find themselves forced to make an impossible choice.



Partly based on director Lulu Wang's real-life experience, *The Farewell* follows a Chinese-American family reunion in Changchun, China, as they support their grandma through her last days. Through the eyes of third-generation Bili, the award-winning dramedy explores family tensions and cultural clashes in a light-hearted fashion.


Based on the life of Phiona Mutesi and directed by Mira Nair, Queen of Katwe is a biographical drama about a girl living in Katwe, a slum of Kampala in Uganda, who learns to play chess and becomes a Woman Candidate Master after her victories at World Chess Olympiads.



CODA is a tender coming-ofage dramedy about a child of deaf adults (CODA) who struggles to balance her deaf family's fishing business with her own dreams of being a singer.



She Said is based on the 2019 book of the same title by reporters Jodi Kantor and Megan Twohey. The film follows the reporters' New York Times investigation that exposed Harvey Weinstein's history of abuse and sexual misconduct against women.



A Ballerina's Tale is a documentary about Misty Copeland, the first African-American woman to hold a main role at the American Ballet Theatre.
